Message from UNICEF HK Chairman

Navigating Troubled Waters to Secure Child Welfare

In 2023, we witnessed children struggling amidst a polycrisis. Across the globe, calamities unfolded with wars persisting and disasters striking. From Gaza to Sudan to Ukraine, densely populated areas such as hospitals, schools, and refugee camps have become targets. Catastrophic disasters followed, with floods in Libya and devastating earthquakes in several countries, while severe droughts, heatwaves, and intense storms driven by climate change continue unabated.

The compounded impact of human-induced calamities and natural disasters has undoubtedly slowed our progress toward the Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs) for 2030. The most vulnerable and youngest among us have borne the brunt of these setbacks. At the halfway mark towards the 2030 SDGs in 2023, two-thirds of global goals for children's rights and well-being are off pace to meet the 2030 target.

Fortunately, time is still on our side to get back on track. If we all unite and continuously support UNICEF's work, we can navigate these thorns and extend a helping hand to children in crisis, bringing them the hope they so rightly deserve. Despite daunting challenges, UNICEF has remained steadfast in supporting children in need, achieving solid results. For example, in 2023:

- UNICEF and its partners provided more than 210 million children with services for the early detection and treatment of child wasting.
- UNICEF delivered 6.2 million doses of the world's first malaria vaccine to seven African countries, marking a historic breakthrough for child survival.
- The UNFPA-UNICEF Global Programme to End Child Marriage continued to advance gender equality, overcoming gender biases and empowering adolescent girls.
- At COP28, the conference recognized the impacts of climate change on children's health and well-being for the first time

Safeguarding Every Child's '7,000 Days of Life'

Beyond supporting UNICEF's global initiatives, UNICEF HK has been unwavering in its commitment to advancing child rights locally. We extend our deepest gratitude to donors and partners who have supported our fundraising endeavours, including the triumphant return of UNICEF Charity Run post-COVID, the launch of 'Child Ally X miffy' monthly donation program, and the 'Champions for Children' corporate membership scheme. These efforts have significantly contributed to the well-being of children in our community.

In our mission to nurture the next generation, UNICEF Young Envoys embarked on inspiring journeys to Child-friendly Cities in South Korea and Shenzhen. Meanwhile, 'SDG Actioner Challenge' for Ethnic Minority Youth and Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs) eLearn Award Scheme empowered students to take action on SDG 13: Climate Action, embodying the responsibilities of global citizenship.

To address the critical challenges children face throughout their development, UNICEF HK is focusing its efforts on the 7,000 Days of Life Campaign. These 7,000 days represent the crucial period from conception until a child reaches adulthood at 18, with a focused emphasis on two pivotal areas: climate change and mental health. Concurrently, we will continue to explore with various stakeholders the implementation of Child-friendly Cities Initiatives in Hong Kong, envisioning an ideal city for future generations.

Happiness will amplify by sharing; one candle can light up thousands. When we bring light to others' lives, we will also enlighten our own path. As we reflect on the obstacles we have overcome, we also look ahead to a horizon filled with hope. We sincerely invite you to continue supporting UNICEF HK, walking alongside us in this era of challenges and opportunities, as we strive to create a brighter future for every child entrusted to our care.

聯合國兒童基金香港委員會主席的話

風雨同舟共濟 守護兒童福祉

2023年,我們目睹兒童在多重危機中掙扎,世界各地戰爭持續不斷,災禍接連而來。從加沙到蘇丹再到烏克蘭等地,人口密集的城區、醫院、學校以至難民營都成為攻擊目標。其他災難性危機也接踵而至,利比亞洪水泛濫,敘利亞、土耳其、摩洛哥等地遭受毀滅性強震,氣候變化導致的嚴重乾旱、熱浪和強烈風暴的出現亦有增無減。

種種天災人禍的疊加影響,拖慢了我們朝向2030年達成可持續發展目標 (SDGs) 的步伐,脆弱、年輕的生命,成為付出代價的無辜群體。聯合國在2015年通過了可持續發展目標 (SDGs),務求在2030年之前建立更和平及繁榮的社會。2023年是邁向可持續發展目標的中間點,但仍有三分之二與全球兒童權利和福祉相關的目標未能追上進度。

幸好,我們還有時間,重回正軌。只要各界團結一致,繼續支持聯合國兒童基金會(UNICEF)的工作,相信我們定能披荊斬棘,將援手遍及危難中的兒童,為他們帶來希望。2023年UNICEF無懼險阻,繼續以實際行動,兌現守護兒童權利的承諾,成果令人鼓舞,當中包括:

- · UNICEF及合作伙伴為超過2.1億名消瘦症的兒童,提供早期診斷及治療服務;
- · 將620萬劑全球首款瘧疾疫苗送抵7個非洲國家,於保障兒童生存方面工作締造重大突破;
- 聯合國人口基金-聯合國兒童基金會「消除童婚全球計劃」,持續推進性別平等,克服性別偏見,為女童賦權;
- · 第28屆聯合國氣候變化大會(COP28)首次確認,氣候變化對兒童健康和福祉的影響。

守護每名兒童「生命中的首7,000日」

著眼香港,聯合國兒童基金香港委員會(UNICEF HK)以不同渠道支持UNICEF全球項目之餘,對推廣本港兒童權益同樣不遺餘力。藉此衷心感謝贊助人及各界伙伴支持我們的籌款項目,例如於新冠疫情後載譽回歸的UNICEF慈善跑,全新推出的「小童盟 x miffy」月捐計劃和「童心商伴」企業會員計劃等,為促進兒童福祉作出的貢獻。

在培育下一代方面,「青年使者」出訪韓國和深圳,踏上「兒童友好城市」考察之旅;「SDG行動派」少數族裔青年教育計劃和「可持續發展目標(SDGs)網上學習獎勵計劃」鼓勵同學實踐聯合國SDG 13 - 氣候行動,履行國際公民責任。

此外,為了全面關顧小朋友在成長過程中的挑戰和重要主題,UNICEF HK的各項行動將以「生命中的首7,000日」為主軸展開。7,000日代表了由母親懷胎至嬰兒長大成人,到達18歲所需的時間,各項目將圍繞其中兩重點 - 氣候變化和精神健康。同時,我們亦將繼續以兒童的視角,攜手各方,進一步探討在香港落實兒童友好城市的道路和方向,為下一代建設他們理想中的城市。

回望過去,我們見證挑戰,展望未來,我們看到希望。每一次努力,每一份支持,都舉足輕重。幸福不會因分享而變少,恰似一支蠟燭能點亮千千萬萬的光芒,而光輝不會黯淡,反而愈加璀璨。我們殷切期望您的支持,與UNICEF HK攜手同行,在這份共享的光明中,我們共同編織出一幅希望的畫卷,讓每一個瞬間都閃耀著無限的可能。

GOAL AREA 1 目標一

Every child survives and thrives 為兒童 助其茁壯成長

In 2023, growing inequities, conflicts and climate change slowed progress and eroded children's rights to survive and thrive. Food poverty - the inaccessibility of nutritious and diversity diet affect 181 million children under 5 in its most severe form.

About 200 million children under 5 suffer from stunting or wasting, while 136 million children aged 5–10 suffer from overweight and obesity.

4.9 million children under 5 died in 2022, with over 80% of deaths in sub-Saharan Africa and southern Asia.

UNICEF led global action to prevent food poverty and reduce the triple burden of malnutrition – undernutrition, micronutrient deficiencies and overweight. UNICEF also supported health interventions across age groups, focusing on the primary health care (PHC) service delivery encompassing households, communities and facilities.

UNICEF worked on Goal Area 1 in 158 countries in 2023, with a total expense of \$3.63 billion, including \$2.47 billion for humanitarian action.

2023年,日益加劇的不平等、衝突和氣候變化減慢了工作進展,侵蝕兒童茁壯成長的權利。糧食貧困,即無法獲得營養豐富的多樣化飲食,以最嚴峻方式影響1.81億名5歲以下兒童的健康。

約2億名5歲以下兒童發育遲緩或罹患消瘦症, 1.36億名5-10歲兒童患有超重和肥胖。

490萬名5歲以下兒童於2022年過世,逾80%來自撒哈拉以南非洲和南亞。

UNICEF率領全球行動預防糧食貧困,減輕營養不良帶來的三重負擔(營養不足、微量營養素缺乏症和超重肥胖)。UNICEF亦為各年齡群體提供健康支援,重點在於提供涵蓋家庭、社區和設施的初級衞生保健(PHC)服務供應。

2023年,UNICEF在全球158國家為達成目標一的總支 出達36.3億美元,其中24.7億用於人道主義行動。





- > 132.9 million children were vaccinated against measles, and more than 400 million vaccinated against polio.
- > UNICEF delivered 2.79 billion doses of vaccines to 105 countries.
- > COVAX has delivered 2 billion doses of COVID-19 vaccine to 146 countries since 2021, in the largest-ever vaccine rollout.
- > Through the No Time to Waste Acceleration Plan, 6 million children were reached with severe wasting treatment in the 15 acutely affected countries.

On 5 November 2023, UNICEF Charity Run returned to Hong Kong Disneyland Resort and Sunny Bay, rallying support for the United Nations Sustainable Development Goal (SDG) 3: Good Health and Well-being. In response to global conflicts and disasters, dedicated runners came together to run for every child. Proceeds from the event will advance UNICEF's global efforts in health, nutrition, water and hygiene, and other child rights-related initiatives, building a brighter future for children in need.

World Breastfeeding Week 2023 國際母乳哺育周2023

Celebrated in the first week of August across more than 170 countries, World Breastfeeding Week 2023 was themed 'Enabling Breastfeeding: Making a Difference for Working Parents', supporting working women to continue breastfeeding. In Hong Kong, breastfeeding rates have shown significant growth over the past years, with the rate at hospital discharge increasing from 55% in 2000 to 85% in 2022.

GOAL AREA 2 目標二

Every child learns and acquires skills for the future 為兒童 改善教育及裝備未來

Despite significant increases in access to education, the global progress towards SDG4 remains far off track. Many children and young people lack the skills to navigate personal, social and economic challenges. The digital divide is growing.

While the global number of out-of-school children fell by 9 million from 2015–2021, it has increased by 6 million since then.

Two thirds of 10-year-olds cannot read a simple story or do basic math.

UNICEF launched the Five Million Futures action and advocacy to support 50 countries to improve early learning, parenting and the transition to primary education. We also helped strengthen education systems, including the provision of alternative learning pathways for adolescents, extended curricula to integrate a wider range of skills, and supporting programmes that help youth transiting from school to work.

UNICEF worked on Goal Area 2 in 144 countries, spending an estimated \$1.73 billion, with approximately \$1.07 billion in humanitarian settings.

UNICEF 發起Five Million Futures行動和倡議框架,支持50個國家改善早期學習、育兒和小學教育過渡,並加強教育制度,包括為青少年提供其他學習途徑、强化課程以納入更多技能、及支持幫助青年從學校過渡到工作的計劃。

UNICEF在全球144個國家為達成目標二的總支出預計達17.3億美元,其中預計達10.7億用於人道救援處境。

UNICEF Young Envoys Programme provides local youth with training in leadership, communication, and mobilization, preparing them as advocates for child rights.

Child Friendly Cities Field Trips to Korea and Shenzhen

In summer 2023, Young Envoys observed UNICEF's 'Child Friendly Cities Initiative' in Korea and Shenzhen, learning how community inclusiveness is achieved through children's participation. These experiences broadened the Young Envoys' global perspective and introduced them to child-led models of engagement.

In Korea, Young Envoys visited the Korean Committee for UNICEF, Wanju County Children's Ombudsman's Office, and various child-friendly premises in Jeonju City. They also had the opportunity to exchange with local peers insights on youth initiatives.

UNICEF Club School Programme

The 2022/23 UNICEF Club has shown remarkable impact, with over 400 students from 39 local and international schools organizing nearly 100 campus activities, including virtual art exhibitions, charity sales, donation drives, game booths, and workshops.

These initiatives reached over 15,000 students and teachers, enriching their understanding of child rights, UNICEF's work, and the Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs).

Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs) eLearn Award Scheme 2023

Launched in 2022 by UNICEF HK, SDGs eLearn Award Scheme inspires secondary school students to engage in self-directed learning and practical application of the SDGs, advancing their understanding of global issues and nurturing their global citizenship.

This year saw a threefold increase in participation, with over 7,500 students from 93 schools completing 5,060 SDG-related courses and activities. UNICEF will continue promoting SDGs through youth education, building a sustainable future alongside next generations.

GOAL AREA 3 目標三

Every child is protected from violence, exploitation, abuse, neglect and harmful practices 為兒童 遏制暴力、剝削、虐待、疏忽照顧及有害習俗

The child protection-related SDGs have seen modest, uneven progress. A slight decline was observed in the rate of children in detention, physical punishment and intimate partner violence.

UNICEF made significant progress across all Goal Area 3 results areas. Through a cross-sectoral, five-agency PROSPECTS partnership, we managed to support integration and inclusion of forcibly displaced people in 8 countries.

UNICEF worked on Goal Area 3 in 150 countries, with a total expenditure of \$0.98 billion, including \$0.63 billion for humanitarian action.

- Parenting programmes reached 11.8 million parents and caregivers, and 34.7 million children, adolescents, parents and caregivers accessed mental health and psychosocial support services.
- > 4.5 million children who experienced violence were provided with health, social work, justice or law enforcement services.
- > Programmes addressing female genital mutilation reached over 603,000 girls and women in 20 countries.

GOAL AREA 4 目標四

Every child has access to safe and equitable WASH services and supplies, and lives in a safe and sustainable climate and environment 為兒童 提供食水、環境和個人衞生服務,締造安全、可持續氣候與環境

While the world has expanded access to safely managed WASH services, no region is on track to achieve universal access by 2030. 2.2 billion people lack safely managed drinking water, 3.4 billion lack safely managed sanitation, and 2 billion lack basic handwashing facilities. Meanwhile, 739 million children face high to extremely high-water scarcity, and 436 million live in areas prone to severe water vulnerability.

UNICEF has made great progress in support for safe WASH services. In 2023, 21.5 million people gained access to at least basic sanitation (including 1.2 million people with disabilities); 35.9 million to safe water when needed (including 1.6 million with disabilities); and 24.2 million to basic hygiene (including 1.1 million with disabilities).

In 2023, UNICEF worked on Goal Area 4 in over 158 countries, spending \$1.25 billion, including \$0.88 billion for humanitarian response.

雖然全球範圍內獲得安全管理的食水、個人及環境衞生(WASH)服務更加普及,但未有任何地區的進度符合於2030年之前實現全民覆蓋的目標。仍有22億人缺乏安全管理的飲用水,34億人缺乏安全管理的衞生設施,20億人缺乏基本的洗手設施。同時,7.39億名兒童面臨高度或極度缺水的問題,4.36億人生活在嚴重水資源脆弱地區。

UNICEF在支持食水、個人及環境衞生(WASH)服務方面取得巨大進展。2023年2,150萬人至少可獲得基本衞生設施(120萬為有特殊需要人士);3,590萬人可在需要時獲得安全飲用水(160萬為有特殊需要人士);2,420萬人可獲得基本個人衞生(110萬為有特殊需要人士)。

2023年, UNICEF在超過158個國家為達成目標四的總支出達12.5億美元, 其中8.8億美元用於人道支援。

- > Over 7,500 schools and 3,000 health-care facilities provided with basic WASH services. 7.9 million women and adolescent girls provided with programmes to address menstrual health and hygiene.
- > 5.4 million people used climate-resilient water system and 4.8 million used climate-resilient sanitation facilities. 68 countries adopted child-focused climate resilience programmes.
- > UNICEF expanded support for integrating childsensitive approaches into government disaster preparedness frameworks, from 50 countries in 2021 to 85 in 2023.

GOAL AREA 5 目標五

Every child has access to inclusive social protection and lives free from poverty 為兒童 提供共融社會保障, 免於貧困生活

Economic crises, climate change and conflicts are eroding children's right to live free from poverty, while compounding fiscal pressures prevent countries from fully financing social services to alleviate deprivations. Worldwide, 1.4 billion children under age 15 have no access to social protection, a proven solution to reduce child poverty.

In 2023, UNICEF helped 84 countries strengthen their public finance systems. Engagement with international development partners and the private sector led to 71 countries mobilizing resources for social services.

Many countries' systems became more inclusive. With UNICEF support, together with UN partners: 46 countries had social protection programmes that were gender-responsive or led to transformative gender equality results; 67 had disability-inclusive social protection programmes; 37 supported care work through family-friendly policies.

In 2023, UNICEF worked on Goal Area 5 across 157 countries, spending \$0.85 billion, including \$0.41 billion for humanitarian action.

經濟危機、氣候變化和衝突正在侵蝕兒童免於貧困生活的權利,而複合式的財政壓力又使各國無法為社會服務提供充足資金以減輕貧困。社會保障是減少兒童貧困行之有效的解決方案,但全世界有14億名15歲以下兒童無法獲得社會保障。

2023年,聯合國兒童基金會幫助84個國家加強公共 財政體系,與國際發展伙伴和私營機構的合作促使 71個國家動用資源以提供社會服務。

許多國家體系變得更加共融。在UNICEF和聯合國伙伴的合作支持下,46個國家制定了回應性別議題的社會保障方案或取得變革性的性別平等成果;67個國家制定傷健共享的社會保障制度項目;37個國家透過家庭友好政策支持關懷工作。

2023年,UNICEF在157個國家為達成目標五的總支 出達8.5億美元,其中4.1億美元用於人道主義行動。

- > 79 countries had moderately strong or strong social protection systems in 2023; while 22 had strong systems that can effectively and rapidly respond to humanitarian crises.
- > Over 106 million households had access to UNICEFsupported cash transfer programmes.
- > UNICEF reached 2.9 million families in 49 countries with humanitarian cash transfers.
- > UNICEF-led evidence and advocacy on child poverty brought changes to 39 countries.

Humanitarian response 人道主義行動

In 2023, UNICEF responded to 412 emergencies in 107 countries, including violence, conflicts, disasters and disease outbreaks.

In Gaza, about 13,750 children have died since October 2023. Deprived of clean water, food and medical care, children are dying due to injuries, dehydration, malnutrition and diseases.

In 2023, UNICEF delivered cash assistance to the most vulnerable families with children within six days of the escalation, reaching every fourth person in Gaza (545,073 people, 81,655 families, 262,016 children) in the first round, including a nutrition-sensitive cash payment to 28,840 pregnant and breastfeeding women, and a disability top-up payment to 5,079 children.

Sudan is now in the largest child displacement crisis of the world, with 4 million children fleeing widespread violence in search of safety, food, shelter and health care. UNICEF and partners have provided life-saving assistance to more than 6 million children inside Sudan and neighbouring countries.

2023年,UNICEF在107個國家應對了412次緊急情況, 包括暴力、衝突、災害和疾病爆發。

自2023年10月以來,加沙約有13,750名兒童死亡。無法獲得淨水、食物和醫療服務導致兒童因受傷、脫水、營養不良和疾病而死亡。

2023年,UNICEF在局勢升級後的六天內向有兒童的脆弱家庭提供了現金援助,在第一輪援助中,加沙每四個人中就有一個人(545,073人,81,655個家庭,262,016名兒童)獲得了現金援助,包括向28,840名孕婦和哺乳期婦女發放了營養補助,和向5,079名兒童發放了殘疾補助。

蘇丹正在面臨世界上最大的兒童流徙危機,400萬名兒童為尋求安全、食物、住所和醫療保健而逃離爆發暴力的地區。UNICEF及合作伙伴已向蘇丹境內和鄰國的600多萬名兒童提供了拯救生命的援助。



In Ukraine, two years of destruction and displacement have led to a mental health and learning crisis for children. UNICEF's response focuses on ensuring children access to health care, immunisation, nutrition support, protection, education, safe water and sanitation, social protection, mental health and psychosocial support. In refugee-hosting countries, UNICEF works with governments and partners to strengthen national systems to provide refugee children and marginalized children from host communities with quality education, health care and protection services.

Meanwhile, climate shocks, food insecurity, and disease outbreaks have left families in Afghanistan, the Democratic Republic of the Congo and Myanmar reeling. These and other overlooked emergencies in Haiti, Libya and more are underfunded.

與此同時,氣候衝擊、糧食危機和疾病爆發讓阿富汗、剛果民主共和國和緬甸的家庭陷入困境。此外,海地、利比亞等面對緊急情況的國家都面臨資金不足的問題。

KEY RESULTS

- > UNICEF supported over 26 million individuals with a range of child-protection services and provided alternative care or reunification to over 253,000 children who had been either lost or separated from their families due to conflict or displacement.
- > UNICEF support in emergencies reached over 42 million people with WASH services.
- > 21 countries used the Humanitarian Cash Operations and Programme Ecosystem (HOPE), a UNICEF riskinformed data management solution.

Thanks our major donors The PCD Charitable Trust, The Hennryk Lorenz's Charitable Trust, The Ng Teng Fong Charitable Foundation, Rusy and Purviz Shroff Charitable Foundation and Vantage Capital Markets HK Limited for their wholehearted support.

Extreme weather events are becoming more frequent and intense. Thanks to the support from Rusy and Purviz Shroff Charitable Foundation, resilience measures were implemented to help communities adapt. 3,600 medical staff in two selected pilot provinces had been trained, and approximately 90,000 children under 5 would be served annually.

Humanitarian situation in Pakistan deteriorated drastically due to widespread flooding in 2022, ZeShan Foundation's generous support provided 27,000 people with reliable and sustained access to basic water services through rehabilitation / construction of water systems in Sindh district, Pakistan. 16 schools were provided with WASH facilities, benefiting 2,500 students, including 1,225 girls.

Supply 供應

UNICEF's Supply Division headquartered in Copenhagen is home to the world's largest humanitarian warehouse.

- In 2023, UNICEF procured \$5.24 billion in goods and services for children in 162 countries and areas.
- UNICEF's total 2023 procurement value represented a 37% increase compared to 2019.
- 76% of goods procured was conducted in collaboration with United Nations agencies and development partners.
- The procurement of goods from suppliers registered in programme countries amounted to \$1.47 billion, 42% of all goods procurement.

Change strategies 變革策略

Gender equality

Harmful gender norms are perpetuated at the highest levels. In some countries, they become entrenched in laws and policies that fail to uphold-or that even violategirls' rights. Reducing gender inequality strengthens economies and builds stable, resilient societies that give all people the opportunity to fulfil their potential.

UNICEF supported policies and programmes promoting gender equality in 110 countries in 2023, compared to 85 in 2021. 78 countries deployed at-scale programme to address gender-discriminatory roles and practices including gender-based violence, with the biggest expansion in Eastern Europe and Central Asia, where UNICEF promoted gender-responsive education and parenting.

2023年,UNICEF在110個國家支持促進性別平等的政策和方案,而2021年數目為85個。78個國家推行了大規模方案以解決性別歧視,包括性別暴力,其中以東歐和中亞地區發展最大,推廣促進性別平等的教育和育兒。



Innovation

Innovation is critical to building a better world with and for children. In 2023, UNICEF established a Global Innovation Board to guide its problem-driven innovation portfolio approach to accelerate programme results.

- UNICEF leveraged frontier-tech industry trends to unlock new resources for children and boost emerging economies. Since 2014, the Venture Fund made equity-free investments in 147 open technology solutions from start-ups in 86 countries, reaching over 41 million children.
- UNICEF mobilized core business assets to support its programming and influencing over 5,000 businesses.
- UNICEF reached over 400,000 children with assistive products and inclusive supplies.

- · UNICEF利用最尖端科技趨勢,為兒童提供新資源,促進新興經濟體發展。自2014年以來,風險基金對來自86個國家的初創企業的147項開放技術解決方案進行了無股權投資,惠及4,100多萬兒童。
- UNICEF調動核心商業資產,支持其計劃,並影響了 5,000多家企業。
- · UNICEF為40多萬名兒童提供了輔助產品和傷健共融物資。

Advocacy and Communication

Through our digital channels, media outreach and content, UNICEF continued its position as the leading voice and advocate for children in 2023.

Advocacy for the rights of children in crises has led to robust humanitarian advocacy strategies, winning concrete commitments from Member States to protect children in conflicts against grave violations and pledges from humanitarian donors to invest in initiatives to protect children in conflict.

The 2023 launch of UNICEF's flagship The State of the World's Children report on immunization led to over 10 political events and public commitments from 6 Heads of State and 43 major donors and partners.

The inauguration of the Child Nutrition Fund will serve as an innovative new platform to pool donor and domestic financing for the prevention, identification, and treatment of severe acute malnutrition

Integrated communications and advocacy around the UN 2023 Water Conference led to 34 political commitments and 69 Member States statements on children's right to water security.

傳訊及倡議

通過我們的數字渠道、媒體推廣和內容,UNICEF在2023繼續保持其作為兒童的主要代言人和倡議者的定位。

對危機中兒童權利的倡議促成了強而有力的人道主義倡議 策略,贏得了成員國保護兒童免受衝突而導致嚴重侵害的 承諾,以及人道主義捐助者對投資於保護受衝突影響兒童 的承諾。

UNICEF在2023年推出關於疫苗接種的旗艦報告《世界兒童狀況報告》促成了10多場政治活動,6位國家元首和43個主要捐助者和合作伙伴做出了相關的公開承諾。

兒童營養基金的啟動將成為一個創新的平台,匯集捐助者和國內資金,用於預防、識別和治療急性營養不良。

圍繞聯合國水會議2023開展的綜合傳播和倡議促成了34 項政治承諾和69個會員國關於兒童用水安全和權利的聲 明。

Community engagement social and behaviour change

Social and behaviour change (SBC) helps communities and individuals understand their needs in order to adopt behaviours that help children and women, including the most disadvantaged, to survive and thrive.

In 2023, UNICEF implemented SBC strategies in 104 countries. To better understand the cognitive, social and structural drivers of practices and service uptake, UNICEF generated social and behavioural data in 101 countries.

In 2024, UNICEF is further integrating SBC programming across sectors and will systematically implement effective community feedback and complaints mechanisms for accountability to affected populations in humanitarian crises.

2023年,UNICEF在104個國家實施了SBC策略。為了更好地了解個人在使用服務時的認知、社會和結構驅動因素,UNICEF在101個國家產生了社會和行為數據。

2024年,UNICEF將進一步整合各界別的SBC計劃,並將為受人道危機影響的人口系統化地實施有效的社區反饋和投訴機制。

Engaging and working with young people 與年輕人互動

UNICEF is dedicated to being a child- and youth-powered organization, listening to them and working with them.

Over 50 UNICEF Youth Advocates partnered with UNICEF globally and 26 new Youth Advocates were appointed by UNICEF offices. UNICEF engaged 27.9 million children, adolescents and youth in advocacy, 1.4 million in communication and 36.6 million in online platforms, primarily U-report (UNICEF's digital platform for youth engagement), which registered 6 million new members in 2023.

UNICEF supported national system building for adolescent and youth participation in 55 countries, doubling its 2021 results. Adolescents were consulted on country programme milestones in 89 countries.

A climate poll for COP28 received 770,000 responses from 59 platforms, and voices of young people were included in the COP28 official youth statement.

UNICEF支持55個國家建設青少年和青年參與的國家系統,數目比2021年增加一倍。89個國家在國家計劃里程中徵求了青少年的意見。

為聯合國氣候變化大會COP28舉辦的氣候調查收到了來自59個平台的77萬份回覆,年輕人的聲音被納入COP28官方青年聲明。


