Updates on our work around the world

敘利亞：療癒身心受創的兒童和父母

Syria: Healing traumatised children and parents

歷時14年的內戰結束兩年後，敘利亞仍處於權力更迭的動盪時期。這場曠日彌久的危機讓國民身心俱疲，父母和孩子均需要精神健康和社會心理支援，方能撫平創傷。因此，UNICEF啟動名為Sanadi的心理支援計劃，在阿拉伯語中，意指「我的磐石」，專為孩子的照護者而設；與針對受創兒童的Sawa計劃（意指「在一起」）相輔相成，為當地近4萬名照護者和13萬名兒童提供全方位的社會心理支援。Sanadi計劃涵蓋自我關懷、情緒管理、正向教育和家庭溝通等議題，而Sawa則按兒童的年齡提供合適的支援，增強心理韌性，培養社交技巧。

Two years after a 14-year-long civil war, Syria is still in a volatile phase of power shifts. In such protracted crisis, both parents and children need mental health and psychosocial support for emotional wellbeing. For this reason, UNICEF launched a flagship caregiver programme known as Sanadi, meaning "My Rock" in Arabic, in conjunction with a child-focused initiative called Sawa, meaning "Together", to deliver layered psychosocial support to nearly 40,000 caregivers and 130,000 children in Syria. Sanadi covers self-care, emotional regulation, positive parenting, and family communication, whereas Sawa offers age-specific interventions to build resilience and foster social skills among children.

加沙：教室復修，重拾學業

Gaza: Repairing classrooms to resume education

在加沙，超過八成校舍被戰火徹底摧毀，或用作臨時避難所。自2023年底以來，已有65萬名兒童失學。UNICEF致力為孩子修復教室，清理瓦礫，加固受損結構，再以廢木製作桌椅，務求讓兒童可在安全的環境中學習。用作避難所的學校，幾週內就能修復成功能齊全的教室，甚至包括通風系統等技術升級，以及配備淨水供應保障衛生，確保孩子在持續不斷的衝突中教育無間斷，仍可勇敢追夢。

Over 80% of school buildings in Gaza are either completely destroyed or repurposed as makeshift shelters, and 650,000 children have been out of school since late 2023. From removing rubble and reinforcing unsafe structures, to filling bare spaces with benches and tables made with wood scraps, UNICEF provides these children with safe learning spaces. Shelter-occupied schools are turned into functional classrooms within weeks, often with technical upgrades like ventilation system, as well as water points that support sanitation and hygiene, so that children don't need to give up their education and dreams despite ongoing hostilities.

黎巴嫩：人道行動由青年主導

Lebanon: Youth-led humanitarian action

黎巴嫩和以色列的衝突引致百萬人逃離家園，兒童和青少年被迫輟學。然而UNICEF並沒有把流離失所的青年標籤為被動的受害者，反而透過提供技能培訓，讓他們在人道行動中擔當領導角色，肩負核心成員的重任。UNICEF透過全國義工平台，以及培訓課程附加「以工代賑」模式，動員超過5,500名當地青年參與人道行動，在八百多個庇護所和社區中，貢獻義工時數超過36,000小時，服務人數超過十萬。我們視當地青年為合作夥伴，而不只是受益者，不僅能更有效應對天災人禍，也是對青年領導才能的重要投資。

The hostilities between Lebanon and Israel displaced over 1 million people, severely disrupting the education among youth. Instead of seeing displaced youth only as victims, UNICEF positioned them as key actors in the humanitarian response by providing them with skills and structured roles. More than 5,500 young people were recruited via a national volunteering platform and an accelerated training plus cash-for-work model. They took leadership roles in over 800 shelters and communities, contributing over 36,000 volunteer hours and reaching over 101,000 people. By recognising them as partners, not just beneficiaries, UNICEF creates a blueprint for effective crisis response that also invests in youth capacity and leadership.
